

GROUP ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY STATEMENT

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This Environmental Policy Statement is approved by the Board of Directors of BusinessWatch UK Holdings Limited, hereafter referred to as the BusinessWatch Group, incorporating Business Watch UK Fire & Security Ltd, Securi-Plex Ltd, Remote Monitoring Services Ltd, and Fire Safety Consult Ltd.
